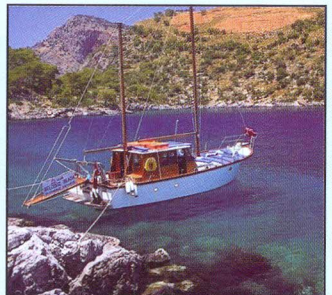

What is Blue Card?

Blue card is a system made for digital follow up of marine motor vehicles' wastes.



Why to use Blue Card?

Waste reception period is easier and faster with blue card, compared to the printed waste notification/transfer forms.

The data is kept online in a safer media, and is easier to access.

Waste notification can be completed in a few seconds for both the blue card owners and the waste reception facilities.

It's our responsibility to prevent marine pollution!

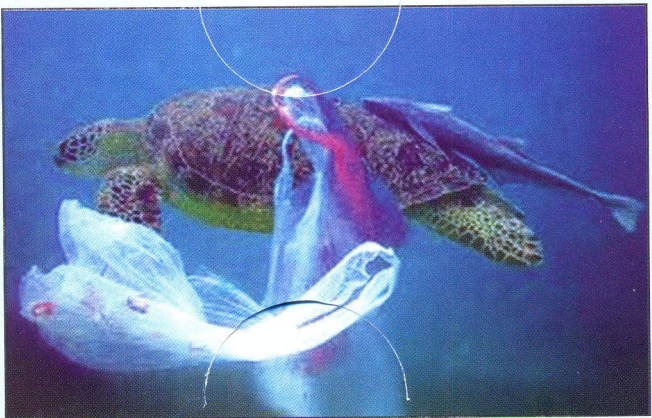
Oily Wastes Dumped into Sea Have Fatal Effect on Marine Ecosystem ...

Who are responsible and in charge, while using Blue Card?

In administrative level, for the regulation, maintenance and inspection of Blue card, **the Ministry of Environment and Forestry** is in charge...

Blue Card can be **obtained** from **marinas, ports and fishing ports**, that are also waste reception points...

Blue Card users are the owners of the marine motor vehicles, defined in the Blue Card Circular.

Inspection of the Blue Card is done by:

- **Ministry of Environment and Forestry**
- **Coast Guard Commandership**
- **Port Authorities**

Blue card users are responsible to show their cards to the inspector in charge, during inspection.



Waste reception points

All ports, marinas and fishing ports have sufficient waste reception facilities.
